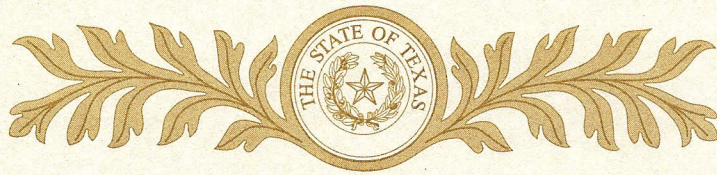


The State of Texas



RESOLUTION


WHEREAS, Avalon High School was recognized as one of the top high schools in the country by *U.S. News and World Report* in its December 10, 2007, issue; and
